## Fire Department Training

The KY Intelligence Fusion Center, the Kentucky Office of Homeland Security and the Kentucky Fire Commission is sponsoring a one day, three and half hour class on:

### ***KY Fire Service Intelligence Training***

**Partnering with the KY Intelligence Fusion Center / Working Together to Protect our Communities!**

*Firefighters are often first to arrive on an incident scene, allowed into industry for the purpose of preplanning, and spend countless hours conducting home inspections. These actions could result in observing suspicious or criminal activity. Suspicious activity, whether occurring in rural or urban settings, can be the key to identifying criminal and terrorist plots being developed on a local, state, or national scale. Providing for the safety of your citizens and firefighters is a top priority of every fire service manager. This class identifies recommended actions and guidance to effectively integrate these observations by our fire service into the KY Intelligence Fusion Center (KIFC) and methods in which information from the KIFC will be provided to our fire service.*

*Kentucky's fire service is certainly not exempt from terrorism and criminal issues. Kentucky's fire service through the efforts of the KY Fire Chief's Assoc, the KY Fire Commission and the KY Office of Homeland Security has taken a pro-active approach to protecting our citizens and firefighters by having a person with a fire service background assigned to the KY Intelligence Fusion Center.*
