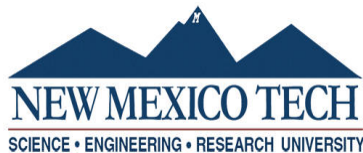

Course Objectives

There are over 5 million First Responders throughout the United States that are likely to be the first ones called or on scene to a terroristic bombing incident. FEMA and the NDPC have recognized the importance to ensure proper training planning, recognition, mitigation, and recovery from these incidents. This is an *Awareness* level course designed to cover the following objectives:

1. Recognition of explosive devices and components
2. Pre and post explosive incident response
3. Terrorism and Energetic Materials
4. Special hazards with explosive incidents

This course is designed for Law Enforcement, Fire Department, EMS, and Special Response Teams that may be called to terroristic incidents. However, any person in private industry or public service that may be a component of the response system is invited to attend.
