State Fire Rescue Training Director's Report

State Fire Rescue Training provided courses for 674 fire departments in the Commonwealth during FY18. This is 84% of the departments. The additional ten hours of training were provided to 384 (48%) departments.

SFRT delivered 8,278 classes and reached 106,643 students. The following is the breakdown of the classes.

816 students registered

745 students attended

We have purchased decontamination equipment for each SFRT area. This equipment will be used at the conclusion of live burns to ensure that all instructors and students' PPE is cleaned prior to leaving the scene. We hope to minimize exposure to fire contaminants and reduce exposure to carcinogens. We also hope that the students will take this practice back to their home department.

We are preparing to purchase more Flashover Chambers and fire engines. The Flashover Chambers will allow us to better meet the request for classes. The fire engines will be used in accredited certification testing and larger trainings such as regional schools and state fire school.

Our accredited certification office has recently completed a successful reaccreditation visit from the IFSAC certification assembly. This reaccreditation will cover a five year period.

Couple of reminders:

Fire Instructor renewals – Even instructor number will renew on January 1, 2020

Odd instructor number will renew on January 1, 2019

Twenty – thirty hours training is currently being scheduled for FY19. Contact your area office to schedule.
